The 10th Mt. Div. was reactivated in Feb 1985 and since that time has been the most deployed division in the United States Army. By design and by hard won reputation, the division will remain extremely active in the years ahead in the Global War on Terrorism.

The 10th Mt. Div. will continue to place Soldiers in harms way far in to the foreseeable future. With 7,000 10th Mt. Div. Soldiers currently deployed and an additional 3,500 deploying this fall, the number of casualties will continue to grow.
